TEENAGE SEGMENT 2 (TWO) PROVISIONS

1. **Mr. R's A+ Driving School will provide a minimum of 6 hours of classroom instruction with a certified Michigan Driver Education Instructor. Classroom instruction shall not exceed 2 hours per day.**
2. **A driving log must be presented to verify that the student has completed a minimum of 30 hours of driving (including 2 hours at night) with a licensed parent/guardian or a designated licensed adult driver 21 or older. A log was presented to the Segment 2 instructor on or before the first classroom session.**
3. **The Student must have held a Level 1 License for not less than 3 continuous months.**
4. Upon successful completion, (attendance 6hrs, classroom assignments, 70% on State test) the student will be issued a **"MICHIGAN DRIVER EDUCATION CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION - SEGMENT TWO"** certifying completion of the requirements of the Mich. Department of State.
 - a. A **\$10.00** replacement fee will be assessed for issuing a new certificate.

TERMS

The Parent or Legal Guardian agrees to pay the total amount of \$60.00 in the form of cash, check, Visa, MasterCard. The total cost of the course must be paid in full on the 1st or 2nd day of class.

In case of a student's absence the class must be made up at a later date to be arranged with instructor.

REQUIREMENTS TO PASS THE COURSE

Passing the State of Michigan Test (70%)

The Student will be allowed up to 3 attempts to pass the State Exam, which requires a score of at least 70%

REFUND POLICY

If for any reason you decide to withdraw from the course before its completion, your refund will be based on the following pro-rated schedule:

- A. After the first day a refund of \$20 will be refunded.
- B. After the first two days NO REFUND WILL BE issued.
